Language

This month we will be working on writing stories! The children are looking forward to working in small groups to write a story with a beginning, middle, and end. They will illustrate, publish (here at Casa) and share their stories with each other.

Saxon Math

Some topics we will be exploring this month are: money (dimes, nickels, pennies), fractions, geometry, dozen and half-dozen, and time (hour and half-hour).
