## On The Way . . .

As we work together through the enrollment process for your child, we'll do our best to keep you informed on what's coming next and where you can get the information you need. Here's some information about things to be on the lookout for.

### **Enrollease**

Casa is going electronic! Beginning with the 2023-24 school year all beginning of the year paperwork will be filled out electronically through a system called Enrollease. This software is designed by the same company that manages our Lottery system; so it is likely many of you already have an account! **Look for further registration details to come to you at the end of July!**

### **Before and After School Enrollment**

# DID YOU KNOW?

## **Sign In/Sign Out**

As a reminder, when a student arrives to school late or is checked out early, the responsible adult must enter the building with proper identification and complete the check out process using our Identikid system. This check out process can take several minutes so please plan accordingly.

## **Withdrawals**

What do you do if your plans change and your student will not be able to attend Casa in the Fall? It is important that you share this information with the school as soon as possible and begin the withdrawal process. As much as we don't want you to go, the earlier you share this news with us, the sooner we can offer an opening to a student on the waiting list.

## **First 20 Days of School**
